GOD SURELY ANSWERS PRAYERS! Twenty-four years ago, my husband and I got the answer of prayer: "WAIT". Recently the "WAIT" was turned into a "YES" when the BFO boys choir and I were invited to attend a Tambul District Youth Camp (pictured below). It is the home area of my husband, Jiwa. In this same area, he was betrayed by some of his tribesmen, which resulted in heavy beatings, assault and even narrowly escaping death. Due to the trauma, our family don't go to the village regularly. God has helped us to bear the hurt with hearty forgiveness and living a life of fully committed to God.

Thank God for His Sustaining Grace, in which, we have taken it on ourselves by forgiving each and everyone involved and were silent for these many years. Since then, our tribes people who strongly believe in compensation claim, tribal fights and 'payback' systems were watching us as we lived a dedicated Christian life.

We were there at God's appointed time! Going back to the same area where our family faced the awful trauma was a challenging feeling but God arranged all that! As Peter Taiga, one of our newly converted street criminals, gave a word of testimony of how he came to know Christ through BFO and with special songs sung by the choir, God's anointing came. Our whole Ayaka tribe in Tambul has repented and is in the process of setting a date to have reconciliation service. Three quarters of our tribe, especially the youth and young fathers have committed their lives to God. Prayer is Powerful!



The children's schooling is a huge challenge. We are SO THANKFUL to GOD for honouring prayers and most of our children did well! Some excitedly rushed home with their awards to show me.

As we begin a new year, The Board of Trustees, I & my family along with the vulnerable children and widows give our "SINCERE AND HEART-FELT THANKS" to every person—child, adult and the elderly for all your contributions in cash and kind, prayer and personal visits to us. Your many ways of support demonstrated Jesus' Love! You keep us feeling and being loved!
